Why: Our need is to pick up trash on NM Hwy 313 between the round-a-bout and Bernalillo. RIO Cycling Club has traditionally picked up 2 miles of this road, but recently we have noticed that the amount of litter and trash on the entire highway between the round about and Bernalillo is in need of clean up.
